Appealing Convictions of Former Clients of Nicola Gobbo in Victoria: Some Issues and Perspectives – Chris Corns

The case of Nicola Gobbo (also referred to "Lawyer X", "EF" and "Human source 3838") has been the subject of extraordinary media coverage and a significant number of appellate judgments concerning attempts to suppress the identity and role of Ms Gobbo as a human source for Victoria Police. More recently, a number of former clients of Ms Gobbo have challenged their convictions in the Victorian Court of Appeal (COA). This article considers the grounds upon which those convictions have been challenged and the operation of s 317 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 2009* (Vic) under which the COA can order the production of documents and other material required by an applicant/appellant. Objections by Victoria Police, and other agencies, to the disclosure of documents on the basis of public interest immunity is also considered.
